feature two remarkable shots I witnessed at Split Rock. I (George Weekes) was playing in a foursome with Herbie Lewis, Ray Woolfolk and John Cavanaugh.

The first shot was made by **Ray Woolfolk** on hole #2 of the North Course. It's a 299 yard par 4 that doglegs to the right. Ray hit his drive into the woods to the right of the fairway. We found his ball pretty quickly, but it appeared Ray was "in jail". It looked like he might be able to chip out into the fairway but to do that required negotiating numerous trees. I thought the only other option was to invoke the lateral hazard rule and take a drop. Ray elected to go for the green which means he had to negotiate about 50 yards of woods (not a few trees, I'm talking forest), and then stop the ball on the green protected front and back by traps. Somehow Ray pulled it off. His shot made it through the woods, rolled through the front trap and stopped about 12 feet from the pin. You can ask Ray if he made the putt. I'm not tellin'.

The other "shot of the day" was made by **John Cavanaugh** on hole #5 of the North Course. This hole is a 491 yard par 5 that doglegs hard left about 100 yards from the green. John hit a good drive; long and straight down the right side of the fairway. He had 200 yards to a blind pin over water and trees. On this day John was having a love affair with his new hybrid so going for the green in two was not out of the question. Instead, he elected to lay up to the dogleg with his wedge. He then proceeded to hole his third shot; another wedge from 100 yards out; very high, soft landing, then one bounce into the bottom of the cup for eagle. HELLO skin !!!
