#### Chambers, Jeffries, Cavanaugh top the Shippen Cup

The last time the Strikers visited Architects's the day started dry and ended with serious precip. This time the initial drizzle gave way to warm dry conditions. On this day the reining club champion did not disappoint. Jimmy Chambers teamed with John Cavanaugh for a match victory and tied for 2nd in stroke play to comfortably maintain his 1st place Shippen Cup standing.

Former club champ Darryl Jeffries moved up to 2nd place with a match victory and T2 place in stroke play. John Cavanaugh needed a 1st place finish in stroke play and a

#### What's the score? In match play you need to know

We all need to make more of an effort in keeping our match play scores in "real time". This means everyone involved in the match knowing where the match stands after every hole. It starts with a little preparation before the match starts. Review your score card. Make sure the course handicap for each player is accurate. Then check the dotted holes (holes where you, your partner and your opponents get strokes). If you are uncertain about your score card, ask for help before your match starts.

Always enter gross scores on your scorecard. After each hole determine if you (your team) won the hole, your opponents won the hole or the hole was halved (tied). Then determine where the match stands and announce it to all players in the match. "We won the last hole and are now two up in the match."

When one player (team) is up by more holes than are left to play, the match is over. The score card should be marked with the winning player/team, number of holes up and number of holes left to "Chambers wins 2&1" (2up with 1 to play). You should then shake hands and complete your round. There is still a stroke play competition to win.
